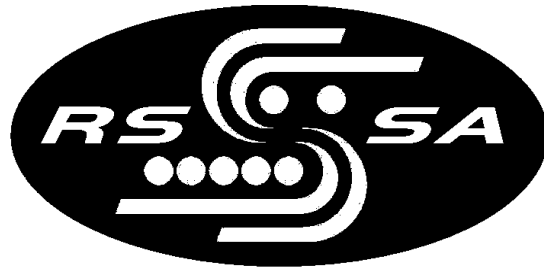

Dear Skateboarders,

Welcome to the world of competitive sport. For many of you the ridged rules of competitive sport may be a new experience.

World Skate (WS) is the official International body for Skateboard, Roller Sport South Africa (RSSA) is a member of WS and therefore our Federation may enter skaters in International competitions.

To qualify for the Olympics skaters accumulated points towards a world ranking. Due to COVID 19 most of the qualifying events were cancelled. World skate decided to award points for National championships 2020 and 2021, each skater will be given the best score out of the 2 competitions. The event must be sanctioned and adhere to all the rules of World Skate.

Europe is in a 2nd lockdown and qualifying events might not happen. We would like our South African skaters to have a fair chance.

It will be a closed event, no spectators. Filmed without any editing and sent directly to 5 international judges or judged by the 5 on a live broadcast. Tabulation and scoring directly in line with the Olympic system.

Venue: The Shred, Paarden Eiland, Cape Town

Categories: PARK – Male and Female STREET- Male and Female

Registration: 21 November 2020 ENTRY FEE: R 450.00 for each category

Payment of entry fees: 07 December 2020

Documents required: 21 November 2020.

- Copy of ID or Passport as proof of South African citizenship
- Fully completed ENTRY FORM
- WADA - ADEL certificate

Being part of an Olympic sport is extremely exciting, but it is not for everybody. To participate in regulated, structured sport skaters will have to follow extremely strict rules.

The **first** to remember is the deadline for entries. If we do not receive your entry and required documents on or before the 21st November, you will not be allowed to enter.

The second important document you need is ADeI because we adhere to the rules of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) and will notify Drug Free Sport South Africa about the championship and request testing. You have to bring your ID/passport to the championship. Do the free online certificate to compete <https://adel.wada-ama.org/> . A certificate is issued on your completion of the course. Search ADeI and do the Alpha course.

In the **third** place only South African Residents with a valid ID/Passport of RSA may enter.

If your entry is accepted the entry fees must be paid by 07 December 2020 and the banking details will be emailed to you.

The format of skating and judging will be as for Olympic competition.
